Thank you for choosing Hamilton Mill Eye Care for your contact lens care. Our mission is to ensure and protect your vision and ocular health while providing resources for your contact lens needs. Contact lenses are medical devices that can lead to serious consequences when contact lenses are not fitting adequately or are not taken care of properly. These complications can potentially lead to permanent damage to your eye health and loss of vision.

In addition to a comprehensive eye examination, a successful contact lens assessment and evaluation includes the following professional services:

1. Measurement of the curvature and size of the cornea to help determine the appropriate lens type and parameters.
2. Evaluation of your corneal health associated with contact lens wear.
3. Follow-up visits to obtain an accurate contact lens prescription for up to 90 days from your examination.

The following contact lens assessment and evaluation fees will be an addition to your comprehensive eye examination. Most vision insurance plans do not cover these additional professional fees, but some give a discount on these services. Your insurance will be checked before your exam and any allowances or discounts will be applied. If you have any questions regarding coverage, please ask in advance.

Yearly Contact Lens Assessment and Evaluation Fees

Level 1 – Spherical or Toric Lens Evaluation - \$60.00

Level 2 – Monovision or Multifocal Lens Evaluation - \$75.00

Level 3 – Specialty/Custom Lens Evaluation & RGP Evaluation - \$85.00

- Minors must have parental/guardian consent before we can provide a contact lens examination.
- By state law, contact lens prescriptions are valid for one year after finalization of the contact lens prescription.
- Contact lens orders may be placed over the phone, in person, or online at www.hamiltonmilleyecare.com. We offer direct shipping at no additional charge for annual contact lens supply orders. Payment is required at the time the lenses are ordered. If you have any questions regarding any insurance benefits towards contact lenses, please ask before ordering.
- Any damage incurred after dispensing is the responsibility of the patient. Contact lenses cannot be exchanged or returned if the boxes have been written on or opened.
- Lenses purchased from other sources or suppliers, cannot be warranted for any defects in our office. It is the patient's responsibility to ensure that all lenses purchased from another supplier meet the exact specifications of your contact lens prescription.
